## The Ten Commandments—Commandment #9 (Exodus 34:28)



**"Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour." (Exodus 20:16)**

### Introduction

When someone reads the words "false witness", many immediately think of a trial and

serious situations where lying should never occur. But what of the every day life? What of the lady with the ugly hat that you do not want to offend? What about the little lie that gets you out of trouble? What about white lies? Innocent lies? What about jesting?

### How serious is lying?

Revelation 21:8 "But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death."

Revelation 21:27 "And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither [whatsoever] worketh abomination, or [maketh] a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life."

Revelation 22:15 "For without [are] dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie."

Notice that those who partake of the second death include ALL liars – not just liars. So the small to the whopper of a lie is covered. [And there is nothing white (pure) or innocent about lies, which reveals how far we have brainwashed ourselves.]

Also notice that in each of the verses, the list of those that do not go to heaven alter a bit but lying is always in the list. Why?

Proverbs 6:16-19 "These six [things] doth the LORD hate: yea, seven [are] an abomination unto him: A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, A false witness [that] speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren." [Notice that lying is listed twice.]

Proverbs 12:22 "Lying lips [are] abomination to the LORD: but they that deal truly [are] his delight."

Why is it an abomination? That is what started this whole mess. Satan lied to one third of the angels (Revelation 12:4) and then to Adam and Eve (Genesis 3:1-6).

### What is a real "Born again" Christian like?

Psalms 40:4 "Blessed [is] that man that maketh the LORD his trust, and respecteth not the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies."

Psalms 119:163 "I hate and abhor lying: [but] thy law do I love."

Proverbs 13:5 *"A righteous [man] hateth lying: but a wicked [man] is loathsome, and cometh to shame."*

Proverbs 14:5 *"A faithful witness will not lie: but a false witness will utter lies."*

Proverbs 14:25 *"A true witness delivereth souls: but a deceitful [witness] speaketh lies."*

Proverbs 30:8-9 *"Remove far from me vanity and lies: give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with food convenient for me: Lest I be full, and deny [thee], and say, Who [is] the LORD? or lest I be poor, and steal, and take the name of my God [in vain]."*

Isaiah 63:8 *"For he said, Surely they [are] my people, children [that] will not lie: so he was their Saviour."*

Ephesians 4:25 *"Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another."*

Colossians 3:9 *"Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds."*

A "born again" Christian will not consider lying fun to do. He will stay far from such conversations.

### Arguments for small lies

Some believe that the little old lady with the ugly hat should be spared from her feelings being hurt. Job 11:3 *"Should thy lies make men hold their peace? and when thou mockest, shall no man make thee ashamed?"* Here we see Job stating that lying does not necessarily bring peace. Only the truth. And if the hat is ugly, the little old woman would want your honest opinion.

Some believe holding back the truth about something for sale so as to get the higher price is not deception. Leviticus 6:2-4 *"If a soul sin, and commit a trespass against the LORD, and lie unto his neighbour in that which was delivered him to keep, or in fellowship, or in a thing taken away by violence, or hath deceived his neighbour; Or have found that which was lost, and lieth concerning it, and sweareth falsely; in any of all these that a man doeth, sinning therein: Then it shall be, because he hath sinned, and is guilty, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he hath deceitfully gotten, or that which was delivered him to keep, or the lost thing*

*which he found."*

### The greatest lie

1 John 2:4 *"He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him."*

2 Thessalonians 2:11 *And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie.*

Do not state that the Ten Commandments are done away with for you then commit the most serious offense.

1 Timothy 1:8-11 *"But we know that the law [is] good, if a man use it lawfully; Knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for menstealers, for liars, for perjured persons, and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine; According to the glorious gospel of the blessed God, which was committed to my trust."*

Why is the law not for the righteous? Because they are already obeying it. The law points out sin. It does not remove it or even allow heaven to be earned. It reveals a Saviour that is willing *"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us [our] sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness"* (1 John 1:9). That includes lying.

1 Timothy 4:1-2 *"Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron."* And one of the greatest demonstrations is to call oneself a Christian and not live in obedience to the Ten Commandments. There should never be lawlessness among Christians. *"But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves"* (James 1:22).

### ▶▶AP, April 29, 2004 - Two Md. Teen Girls Plead Guilty in Beating

Two teenage girls admitted Wednesday they attacked a 12-year-old girl at a birthday party because a boy kissed her on the cheek. The beating put the girl in a coma for

three weeks. Police and prosecutors said Nicole's beating began when a boy at the party, acting on a dare, kissed her on the cheek. The mother of the girl celebrating her birthday was apparently offended because the boy was supposed to be her daughter's boyfriend. The mother allegedly urged her daughter to "handle your business," which said meant the girl was supposed to defend the family's honor.

### ▶▶CNS, April 28, 2004 - No TV? Indiana families find it's no problem

For some families at St. John the Evangelist Parish in St. John, there was no ABC or CBS, no NBC or UPN April 19-25. Not even any Fox. For the fourth year the parish school observed National TV Turnoff Week. That meant no television and, in some cases, no videos, DVDs or video games. People read. They colored. They played sports. They went skating. In short, they survived and prospered. Robert and Theresa Birlson have four children but only one television. The family as a whole averages 30 minutes of watching television each week; the children -- Olivia, 10, Emily, 7, Andrew, 4, and Sophia, 2 -- watch five to six hours a week. For the turnoff week, Robert Birlson said, the family played games and cards. They read newspapers. The children did their homework. "We did it last year, so the kids knew it was coming," said their father. He sees the week as a great thing -- "the less TV the better; more reading the better."

**COMMENT:** Psalms 101:3 *"I will set no wicked thing before mine eyes; I hate the work of them that turn aside; [it] shall not cleave to me."* Remember, wicked is inclusive of all that is not acceptable before God - lying, cheating, stealing, any form of sex including revealing more skin than should be revealed, etc. And besides, does God want you wasting your time?

### ▶▶CBN, April 20, 2004 - Study Finds Many Christian Teens Steal Christian Music Online

Christian teens are stealing Christian music through Internet downloads and CD burners at the same rate non-Christians are stealing secular music, according to a new study. Christian pollster George Barna completed a study on teens and piracy for the Gospel Music Association. The study, which has not been made public, showed only 10 percent

of Christian teens considered music piracy to be morally wrong, according to The Dallas Morning News. But Word Records president Barry Landis says stealing Christian music is like stealing Bibles -- and just as wrong. Gospel Music Association President John Styll says sales of Christian albums dropped more than five percent last year, in large part because of Internet downloads and CD burnings.

**COMMENT:** Referring to Jesus as 'Saviour' alone is one of the reasons that has made Christianity so weak. We are to *"grow in grace, and [in] the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ"* (2 Peter 3:18). The Lord has rule in our lives. One is *"Thou shalt not steal"* (Exodus 20:15). And just because you may believe you are SAVED, does not really mean you are. *"Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God"* (1 Corinthians 6:9-10).

### ▶▶Newsweek, April 19, 2004 - 'Get Your Praise On'

At these new booze-free nightclubs, DJs spin and patrons shake in the name of Jesus Christ. No dirty dancing allowed. Not that all Christian clubs strike the balance in the same way. At Station 3:16 in Bakersfield, Calif., the evangelizing is more manifest. Every concert involves a Gospel presentation, and audience members receive response cards to fill out if they decide to choose Christ. But at the Door in Dallas, non-Christian bands mix with Christian ones. "We call it 'religious desegregation'," says founder Russell Hobbs. "We're not afraid of people being exposed to other things."

**COMMENT:** 1 John 2:16 *"For all that [is] in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world."* Just because drugs, alcohol, and sex have been taken out of the music scene does not make it approved of heaven. The need to dance is still a lust of the flesh. The dance of the Bible is much different than the dance of today, but the test comes in comparing ourselves with Jesus

and the apostles. None of them are found dancing. They worked (including secularly),

taught, and preached.

**THAT THOU MAYEST PROSPER AND BE IN HEALTH, EVEN AS THY SOUL PROSPERETH** (3 John 1:2)



**HEALTH SNIPPET:**

**Topic: Do Not Dwell**

Luke 5:27-28 *And after these things he went forth, and saw a publican, named Levi, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he said unto him, Follow me. And he left all, rose up, and followed him.*

As soon as Matthew (Levi) was called, he did not consider the consequences of his actions. He knew what was the right thing to do and immediately acted upon it in an abrupt manner.

The same goes for health. How many times have you wanted to walk for at least a half hour a day? You may even feel good about it and want to get started right away. A 100% goal may be to walk every day. But what happens? You may consider that the minimum is to walk three days a week. So now you talked yourself into less than 50% effort. Subtract from that the days the weather is not perfect. And subtract from that the days you say that 15 minutes is good enough because you have things to do. If you still walk at all, you have at least come down to about a 25% effort. Why? Because you dwelled. What should you have done? Determine to walk everyday

- 2 T yeast
- 2 T molasses
- 2¼ c warm water

Mix together and let sit 5 minutes

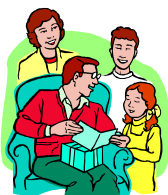
- 2½ c whole wheat flour

even if it is raining, short of a hurricane of course.

Now that is just about walking. But the issue here is to not dwell. If you know what is right, do it. Do not even consider the minimum or even what your friends may think. Because if you dwell long enough, you can talk yourself out of everything and nothing will ever change.

**Character Examples From the Bible – Elijah before King Ahab**

1 Kings 18:17-20 *And it came to pass, when Ahab saw Elijah, that Ahab said*

*unto him, [Art] thou he that troubleth Israel? And he answered, I have not troubled Israel; but thou, and thy father's house, in that ye have forsaken the commandments of the LORD, and thou hast followed Baalim. Now therefore send, [and] gather to me all Israel unto mount*

*Carmel, and the prophets of Baal four hundred and fifty, and the prophets of the groves four hundred, which eat at Jezebel's table. So Ahab sent unto all the children of Israel, and gathered the prophets together unto mount Carmel.*

Elijah was very much disliked by Ahab because Elijah prophesied things that Ahab did not care to hear. But most of all Elijah gave messages from God pointing out the wrong things Ahab was doing. Now Elijah knew Ahab would not like those messages. At the same time Elijah was one who

obeyed God in all that was asked of him. So even when faced with a situation that is not pleasant, Elijah still did what God told him to do. Children are faced with many uncomfortable situations because life is about experience every single day. To allow a child to not perform a task because they are uncomfortable is to prepare them to escape future duties. The more we

encourage them to perform the task, even when uncomfortable, the more we prepare them to face future challenges. And this is true even if the task is considered insignificant. Encouraging them in the right manner is the key. Remind them that their guardian angel is with them if they are scared.

## ANSWERS FOUND IN THE SCRIPTURE OF TRUTH (Daniel 10:21)



**QUESTION #1 – Carlisle, PA – What is the definition of blaspheme?**

**ANSWER #1 – Mark 2:7**

*“Why doth this [man] thus speak blasphemies? who can forgive sins but God only?”* One Bible definition is a mere man claiming to be able to forgive sins.

Revelation 16:9 *“And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: and they repented not to give him glory.”* Taking the name of God in vain is blaspheming God. That includes using the name inappropriately in speech, but more importantly, taking the name of God upon yourself and living a whole different lifestyle. In other words, saying one is a Christian and still committing known sin.

**QUESTION #2 – Carlisle, PA – Does the Bible really identify the method of baptism?**

**ANSWER #2 – Romans 6:3-4** *“Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the*

*Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.”* The only method of baptism that equates to this verse by action is that of single emersion because Christ was wholly buried in the tomb and rose only once.

**QUESTION #3 – Carlisle, PA – Does frequent earthquakes identify that Jesus is coming soon?**

**ANSWER #3 – Matthew 24:7-8** *“For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places. All these [are] the beginning of sorrows.”* If you read carefully, the word “beginning” means just that. It is the beginning of the difficult days. Therefore, no, earthquakes are not a sign today that Jesus is coming soon – they were a sign of the beginning many years ago when they were greatly on the increase. We are no longer at the beginning of sorrows but at the end. Your parents and grandparents heard that Jesus is coming soon because of the earthquakes. That is when the prophecy began to be fulfilled. Now the numerous earthquakes just substantiate what we already know.

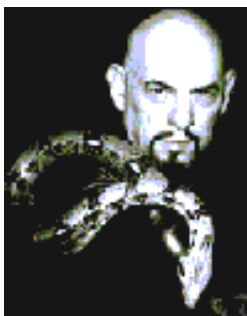
